

Training Cost Assumptions

The methodology used to develop the training cost assumptions comes from the Lead Fees Rule, the 2008 Residential RRP Rule, and the Minor Amendments Rule.

Some estimates were modified under the assumption that the P&CB rule training would be shorter, less intensive, and potentially not require in-class training (i.e, on-line training).

Wage rates from BLS were used to calculate time burden.

Federal per diem for meals and mileage rates were used to calculate travel cost.

For travel distance, training is assumed to be within a reasonable driving distance (50 miles each way) with an overnight stay in a hotel not being required.

Range of Training Cost Estimates

On-line: \$145 (tuition - \$45, training time burden - \$100)

Classroom: \$455.39 (tuition - \$90, training time burden - \$200, travel and meals - \$165.39)

On-line: \$70 (tuition - \$20, training time burden - \$50)

Classroom: \$310.39 (tuition - \$45, training time burden - \$100, travel and meals - \$165.39)

On-line: \$5 (assumes a time burden of 10 minutes)

Classroom: \$15 (assumes a time burden 30 minutes)
